- Strengthening negotiators' mandates to address strategic issues
- Identifying tensions between the implementation of SDGs and the CBD objectives, and explore solutions
- Designing a robust Measurement, Reporting and Verification (MRV) system
- Facilitating an Action Agenda together with different groups (youth, businesses, women, local authorities, indigenous peoples and local communities, etc.)
- Integrating the new biodiversity framework as a basis for the post-SDGs era and the road to the 2050 vision “Living in Harmony with Nature”

Key issues (cont.)

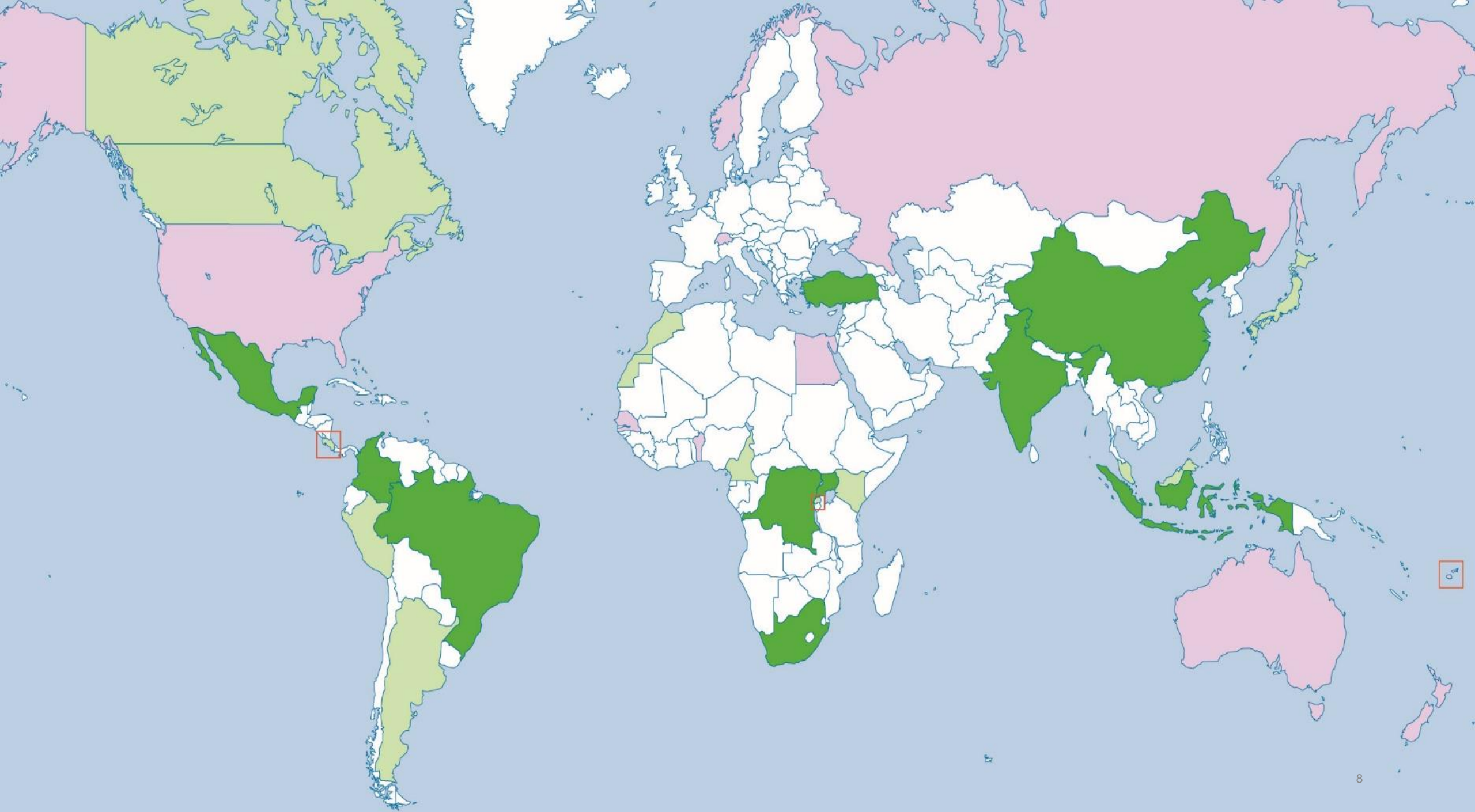


- Taking part in awareness-raising to mobilize broadly and strategically in the build-up to 2020
- Engaging with the finance sector and improving resource mobilization for the implementation of the post-2020 framework
- Overcoming the deadlock regarding the implementation of the biodiversity targets
- Improving the integration of CBD COP decisions into sectoral policies and strategies (energy, transport, infrastructure, justice, social, etc.) that have an impact on biodiversity

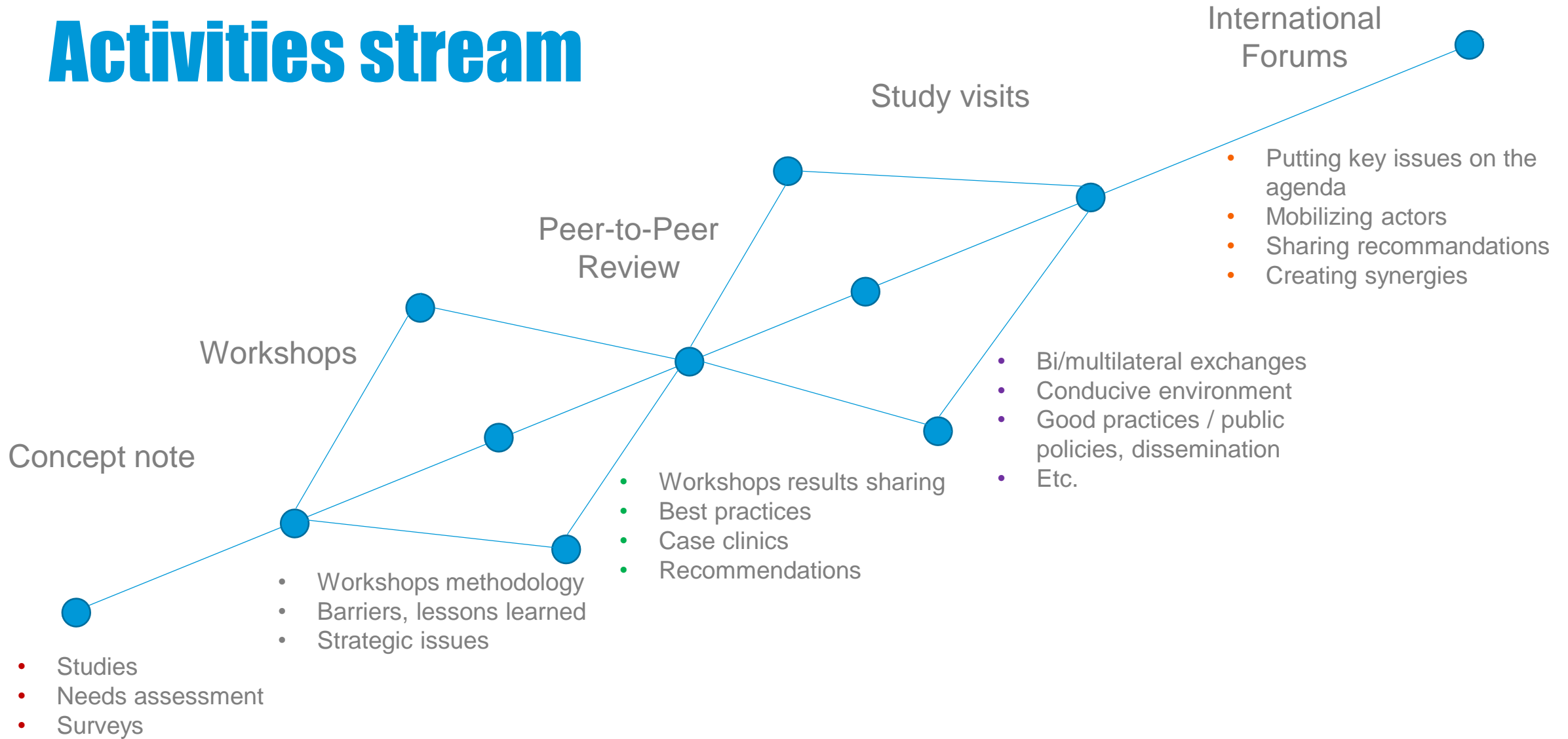
